



- Introduction to Famous artists and their works.




Why should you consider studying Science in 1st Year

Students who are curious about the world & creative. Students who enjoy practical work like conducting experiments.






Course Content

Many of the skills you learn while studying science such as problem solving and investigation skills are very useful outside of school and will be of use to you in whatever job you choose to do.

After the Junior Certificate, Science splits into four lab science subjects: **Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Ag Science.** If you would like to choose any of these subjects in Leaving Certificate it is important that you take Science as a Junior Cycle subject
